

- 1— ENTRIES which must be accompanied by Entrance Fees TO BE IN THE HANDS OF TOURNAMENT SECRETARY, c/- Foster Golf Club, P.O. Box 35, Foster, 3960, **Wednesday MARCH 3rd**, 2010. Late or telephone entries will only be accepted subject to the capacity of the course.
- 2— Entries are restricted to 'bona fide' members of Club's affiliated with the Victorian Golf Association, or of golf clubs registered with such State or Overseas Associations, as are affiliated with or recognized by this Association, or of club affiliated with the Victoria Golf League. The Tournament Committee shall have the right to refuse entry of any person, without being required to give a reason for such refusal.
- 3— The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of golf as adopted by the Royal & Ancient Club of St. Andrew's, Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force on the course on which the competition takes place.
- 4— Any protest must be lodged in writing at the Club House before 6 p.m. on the day on which the dispute arises.
- 5— If a dispute takes place, it shall be decided by the Tournament Committee in charge of the competition, whose decision shall be final. Provided however, that the tournament Committee if in doubt shall have the right to refer such dispute to the Council of the Victorian Golf Association.
- 6— The Tournament Committee., or such persons as they may authorise, shall have the following powers:
  - (a) To permit any player who is not ready to start at his authorized time to start at a later hour.
  - (b) In every event to draw competitors against each other for the day in such a manner as they may arrange, and select a partner for competitor whose partner is not ready at the first tee at the time appointed to start.
  - (c) To alter or vary the conditions— except 2,3 and 6(a)- or programmes, should they deem it advisable.
  - (d) To limit the number of entries in any one event and alter the time of starting of any event.
- 7— TIES, Ties in scratch events 1, 10 and 11 will be decided by play-off, on holes decided by the Tournament Committee, or as the Tournament Committee may decide. Ties in handicap events shall be decided by count back using the approved ACR method of count-back.
- 8— No competitor or pair may win more than (1) one trophy , with the exception of Nearest the Pin Events.
- 9— The Tournament Committee shall consist of appointed members of the Foster Golf Clubs, Match and Handicap Committee.
- 10— Players must register with the starter 15 minutes prior to hit off time.
- 11— All competitors will be made honorary members of the Foster Golf Club for the duration of the tournament.
- 12— All entrants must have a current Golf Australia handicap or W.G.A handicap. Maximum male handicap is 36, with the maximum ladies handicap being 45.
- 13—LADIES EVENTS. All Handicaps must be WGV Handicaps and winners of Ladies Events must produce their official WGV Handicap, and any Handicap alterations made by the Tournament Committee to be for the duration of the Tournament only. Teams event must consist of players from the same club with scores converted from scratch to Stableford for this event.
